

CAMP SESSION- RULES & REGULATIONS

Welcome Campers!

The Camp at Carmel Valley is a special place. The home of Douglas Ranch Camp since 1946, it has nurtured thousands of young boys and girls to become responsible and successful adults. In keeping with the history and traditions of The Camp and for the safety and respect of this space, we ask that you follow these simple rules & regulations:

Fireworks

The Camp is located in an extreme fire danger zone. Fireworks are prohibited. Any fireworks will be confiscated and returned upon your departure. Campers using fireworks will be asked to leave the Camp without a refund and the sheriff will be called. There is a \$1,000 fine or imprisonment in the County jail for up to one year for the unlawful use of fireworks.

Firearms

Firearms are prohibited. Campers possessing firearms will be requested to leave without a refund.

Meal Service and Cooking

Breakfast is included in both our Basic and Deluxe Glamping packages. Additional meals are available for pre order at an additional cost during our Deluxe Glamping Weekends. Campfires

Camper campfires are prohibited. Hosted campfires will take place during our Deluxe Glamping Weekends on the Treetop Terrace on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday evenings.

Camp Guests

Only registered The Camp guests are allowed. No outside visitors. Children must be supervised at all times.

Alcoholic Beverages

Consuming alcoholic beverages at the Camp is permitted. Please be safe and drink responsibly.

Smoking and Vaping

All forms of smoking and vaping are prohibited.

Vehicles

- 5 mph maximum speed limit at all times.
- No parking in Sunset Camp.
- Parking is provided in the lower lot near the entrance.

Camp Gate

The Camp Gate will be closed between the hours of 9PM - 7AM. Campers need to be back onsite by 9PM.

Pets

- The dog fee is \$50 per pet per stay for cabins and \$80 per pet per day for houses. An additional pet can be added for \$40 per pet per day for houses.
- Maximum two dogs per cabin or house
- Please clean up after your pet.
- Not permitted in The Great Hall, on the tennis courts, or in the swimming pool area.
- Must always be under control of owner and on leash.

Sunset, Solstice and Sunrise Cabin Villages

- Smoking, Vaping, Fires, and Cooking are not permitted.
- No foreign objects in toilets.
- Limit Showers to 5 minutes.
- Use trash receptacles.
- No parking.
- Cabins can only be locked from the inside while occupied.

Valuables

Please bring valuables at your own risk or leave locked in your car.

Swimming Pool Area

- No Pets.
- Hours 8 AM to 8 PM.
- Adult supervision required.
- Food is permitted. No cooking or glass containers.
- No diving or running.

Archery Range

- Open Saturdays and Sundays during Deluxe Glamping Weekends. Times vary and will be made available at check in.
- Sign up required. Sign up sheet made available during check in.

Tennis Courts

- Skateboards, Scooters, Rollerblades, Bikes and Pets are not permitted.

Equine Center

- Off-Limits. Please stay out of this areas.

Noise

- Quiet Hours 10 PM - 8 AM.
- Please put cell phone on mute and limit calls to emergency only during Quiet Hours. Amplified music, drumming, loud talking or singing, or any other loud disruptive noises are not permitted during these hours.
- We ask everyone to be part of The Camp Community during their stay and respect each other's quiet enjoyment.

Evacuation Plan

In the event of fire or other natural disaster that requires evacuation of The Camp, you will hear an air horn go off throughout The Camp and be requested to gather your belongings together as quickly as possible and meet on the Constellation Court. The Camp Hosts will be providing directions on the safest way to evacuate whether by vehicle or on foot through the neighboring properties.
