

## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

Welcome Campers!

The Camp at Carmel Valley is a special place. The home of Douglas Ranch Camp since 1946, it has nurtured thousands of young boys and girls to become responsible and successful adults. In keeping with the history and traditions of the Camp and for the safety and respect of this space, we ask that you follow these simple rules & regulations:

### **Social Distancing**

The Camp strictly adheres to Social Distancing Guidelines. Please always maintain at least a 6 ft. separation from other Campers. Should you need for some reason to come closer than 6 ft. wear a mask. All gathering areas at the Camp allow plenty of space for Social Distancing and you should not have to wear a mask unless you voluntarily want to wear one. The Camp follows strict cleaning and sanitizing protocol.

### **Fireworks**

The Camp is located in an extreme fire danger zone. Fireworks are prohibited. Any fireworks will be confiscated and returned upon your departure. Campers using fireworks will be asked to leave the Camp without a refund and the sheriff will be called. There is a \$1,000 fine or imprisonment in the County jail for up to one year for the unlawful use of fireworks.

### **Cooking**

Cooking is only allowed in the Camp Cooking area which is between the Great Hall and the Constellation Court. Picnic tables, gas grill, grill top, burners and washing stations are provided. We request that there be no cooking or eating food in the Sunset Camp. Food is allowed in the pool area.

### **Campfires**

Camper campfires are prohibited. The Camp will provide a friendship fire nightly from 8:00 pm for families and from 9:00 pm until 11:00 pm for adults on the Treetop Terrace. Making smores is recommended.

### **Camp Guests**

Only registered Camp guest are allowed. No outside visitors.

### **Alcoholic Beverages**

Consuming alcoholic beverages at the Camp is permitted. Please drink safely and be responsible.

## Smoking and Vaping

Smoking and vaping are allowed only in designated smoking areas.

## Vehicles

- 5 mph maximum speed limit at all times.
- No parking in Sunset Camp. Unloading and loading of vehicles only.
- Parking is provided on the sports field.

## Pets

- The pet fee is \$30 per day.
- Please clean up after your pet.
- Not permitted in The Great Hall, on Tennis Courts, or Swimming Pool area.
- Must always be under control of owner and on leash.

## Sunset Camp

- Smoking and Vaping, Fires, Cooking or Food are not permitted.
- No Foreign Objects in Toilets.
- Limit Showers to 5 minutes.
- Use Trash Receptacles.

## Swimming Pool Area

- No Pets.
- Hours 8 am to 8 pm.
- Adult Supervision Required.
- No Glass Containers.
- No Diving or Running.

## Archery Range

- Open Saturday 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm.
- Adult Supervision Required.

## Tennis Courts

- Skateboards, Scooters, Rollerblades, Bikes and Pets are not permitted.

## Equine Center/Solstice/Sunrise Camps

- Off-Limits. Please stay out of these areas.

## Noise

- Quiet Hours 10 PM to 8 AM.
- Please put cell phone on mute and limit calls to emergency only during Quiet Hours.
